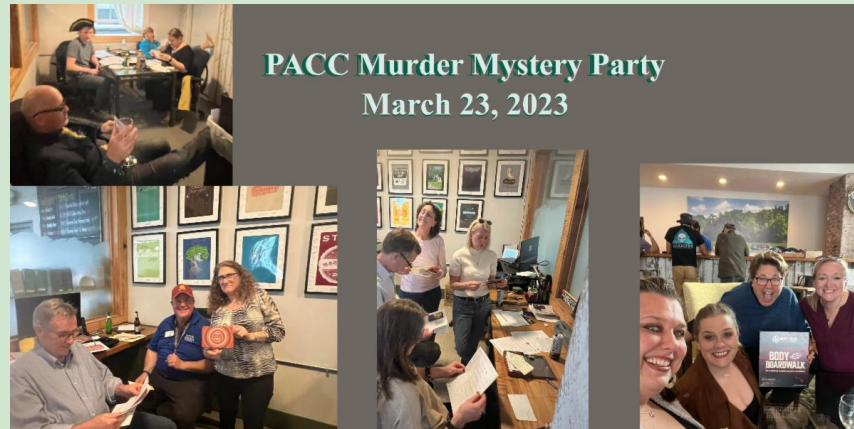
PACC's Executive Secretary Position is Open
